1.1 What is Spectre Stats?

What is Spectre Stats?

Spectre Stats is a competition and performance-tracking app built for bowlers who want more than a scorekeeper. Whether you bowl in a weekly league, compete in tournaments, or just want to understand your game better, Spectre Stats gives you the tools to record how you bowl, spot your trends, and improve over time.

☐ Built for Competitive Bowlers

Spectre Stats is designed specifically for bowlers who take their game seriously — league bowlers, tournament competitors, and serious recreational players alike. Instead of simply keeping score, it captures the **why** behind your results: which balls you used, what conditions you faced, and how your performance has changed over time.

- ☐ Log and review every competition — leagues, tournaments, and practice sessions
- ☐ Track detailed shot data and watch your performance trends develop
- ☐ Manage your entire ball arsenal with notes, maintenance history, and oil pattern performance
- ☐ Connect to the Spectre Cloud ecosystem if your pro shop uses Spectre Cloud

📊 What Can You Do With Spectre Stats?

Here's a quick look at the core areas of the app:

Feature Area	What It Does
📊 Shot & Performance Tracking	Record shot data per frame, game, or session. Chart your averages and trends over time.
📊 Competition Logging	Log league play and tournaments. Track opponents, results, and session outcomes.
📊 Arsenal Management	Keep notes on each ball, log surface changes and maintenance, and match balls to oil patterns.
☁️ Cloud Integration	Connect to Spectre Cloud for shared arsenal data and cross-device sync.

🌩 Part of the Spectre Ecosystem

Spectre Stats is developed by **BowlDevs** — the same team behind **Spectre Cloud** pro shop software. The two apps are designed to work together: if your pro shop uses Spectre Cloud, your drilling specs and ball data can flow directly into Spectre Stats. But Spectre Stats is also fully capable as a standalone tool — no pro shop connection required.

1.2 Who is Spectre Stats for?

Who is Spectre Stats for?

Spectre Stats is built for bowlers who want to understand their game — not just track their scores. If you've ever wondered why you bowled well on one pair of lanes but struggled on another, or which ball performs best on a particular oil pattern, Spectre Stats is the tool designed to help you find those answers.

☐ League Bowlers

If you compete in a weekly or seasonal league, Spectre Stats helps you build a detailed picture of your performance over an entire season — not just game by game, but across different houses, conditions, and nights.

- ☐ Log every league session and track your running average over the season
- ☐ See which balls and surfaces are working best at your home house
- ☐ Review past sessions before returning to a venue so you arrive prepared
- ☐ Keep maintenance records so you always know the current surface of every ball

☐ Tournament Competitors

Tournament bowling introduces variables that league play doesn't — unfamiliar houses, challenging oil patterns, and the pressure of single-game elimination formats. Spectre Stats gives you a competition record you can study and learn from between events.

- ☐ Log tournaments separately from league play and track results over time
- ☐ Record which balls you used on each pattern and how they performed
- ☐ Build a history of results across different venues and formats
- ☐ Identify trends in your tournament performance — where you're improving and where you're not

Performance-Focused Recreational Bowlers

You don't have to bowl professionally to benefit from better data. If you're a serious recreational bowler who wants to improve — whether that means raising your average, learning to read oil patterns, or simply being more deliberate about your equipment choices — Spectre Stats gives you the same tools the competitive bowlers use.

- Track practice sessions alongside competition results
- Set a baseline and measure your improvement over weeks and months
- Get more intentional about which ball you throw and why

Bowlers With a Serious Arsenal

If you own multiple balls and actively manage their surfaces, Spectre Stats functions as a complete arsenal management system. Keeping track of coverstock adjustments, cleaning schedules, and which ball works best in which conditions becomes much easier when it's all in one place.

- Store detailed notes on every ball in your bag
- Log surface changes, resurfacing, and maintenance history
- Record oil pattern performance so you can make smarter equipment choices at the lanes
- Connect with Spectre Cloud if your pro shop uses it — pull in drilling specs automatically

1.3 How to sign up

How to sign up

Getting started with Spectre Stats takes just a few minutes. You can sign up through the mobile app on iOS or Android, or directly through the web — whichever is most convenient. Once your account is created, your data syncs across all your devices automatically.

☐ Sign Up on Mobile (iOS or Android)

1. Download **Spectre Stats** from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store — search `Spectre Stats` or look for the app by BowlDevs.
2. Open the app and tap **Sign Up** on the welcome screen.
3. Enter your **name**, **email address**, and a **password**.
4. Tap **Create Account** to continue.
5. Check your inbox for a **verification email** and tap the confirmation link to activate your account.
6. Once verified, sign in and complete your profile setup.

⚠ **Verify:** Confirm the exact sign-up flow, available login methods (e.g. Sign in with Apple, Google), and whether email verification is required before first use.

☐ Sign Up on the Web

1. Open a browser and go to `spectrebowling.com`.
2. Click **Sign Up** or **Get Started**.
3. Enter your **name**, **email address**, and a **password**.
4. Click **Create Account**.
5. Check your inbox for a **verification email** and click the confirmation link.
6. Sign in and complete your profile.

△ **Verify:** Confirm the exact web app URL (e.g. `stats.spectrebowling.com`) and whether the sign-up flow differs between mobile and web.

☐ Setting Up Your Profile

After creating your account, you'll be prompted to fill in a few details that help personalize your experience in the app.

- ☐ **Display name** — how you'll appear in the app
- ☐ **Dominant hand** — right- or left-handed
- ☐ **Bowling style** — e.g. stroker, tweener, cranker
- ☐ **Home bowling center** — your regular house for league or practice

△ **Verify:** Confirm the exact profile fields shown during onboarding, and whether any are required vs. optional.

☐ Free Account vs. Spectre Stats Pro

Spectre Stats offers a free tier to get you started, with an optional **Pro subscription** that unlocks advanced features for serious competitors.

☐☐ Already Have a Spectre Cloud Account?

If you or your pro shop already uses **Spectre Cloud**, you may be able to link your accounts to share arsenal and ball data between the two apps. Check the **Spectre Cloud Integration** section for setup instructions.

Tip: After signing up, the best first step is adding your bowling balls to your arsenal — even basic notes like ball name and surface grit will make your competition logs much more useful from day one.

1.4 Available platforms

Available platforms

Spectre Stats is available on iOS, Android, and web — so you can log a session at the lanes from your phone, then review your stats in detail from a browser at home. Your data syncs automatically across every device you use.

iOS — iPhone & iPad

The Spectre Stats iOS app is available on the Apple App Store and works on both iPhone and iPad.

1. Open the **App Store** on your iPhone or iPad.
2. Search for .
3. Tap **Get** to download and install the app.
4. Open the app and sign in to your account — or create one if you haven't already.

△ **Verify:** Confirm the minimum iOS version required, whether the app is optimized for iPad (native layout vs. scaled iPhone view), and the direct App Store URL or universal link.

Android

The Spectre Stats Android app is available on the Google Play Store.

1. Open the **Google Play Store** on your Android device.
2. Search for .
3. Tap **Install** to download the app.
4. Open the app and sign in — or create a new account.

△ **Verify:** Confirm the minimum Android version required and the direct Google Play Store link.

Web Browser

No app download needed — Spectre Stats is also accessible in any modern web browser. The web version is a great option for reviewing stats, managing your arsenal, and updating competition records from a desktop or laptop.

1. Open your browser and go to `spectrebowling.com`.
2. Click **Sign In** and log in to your account.

The web version works with all major browsers:

- Google Chrome
- Mozilla Firefox
- Apple Safari
- Microsoft Edge

⚠ **Verify:** Confirm the exact web app URL (e.g. `stats.spectrebowling.com`) and whether any features are unavailable or limited on the web version compared to mobile.

Syncing Across Devices

Spectre Stats uses cloud sync, so everything you log on one device is available on all the others. There's nothing to set up — sync happens automatically whenever you're connected to the internet.

- Log a session on your phone at the bowling center
- Open the web app at home and your data is already there
- Switch between iOS and Android devices without losing anything

⚠ **Verify:** Confirm whether Spectre Stats supports any offline mode (e.g. logging a session without an internet connection and syncing later).
