

Plug work

Doing a good job plugging your bowling ball is critical to achieving a professional look once the work is done. Here are the steps to make sure you do it right:

1. Prepare your Hole



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- Prepare your holes
 - 1. Redrill if the hole is bevelled (or cut at 45°)
 - 2. Clean the inside of the hole
 - 3. Plug Dam at least ¼ away from hole
 - 4. Use one pump at a time
 - Using too much product will cause heat and cracking

2. Once hardened



- Once hardened
 - 1. Make sure your machines is zeroed out 0-0
 - 2. Cut using a “plug cutter”
 - 3. Sand the section using Spinner or Sanding machine
 - 180 grip and up
 - Make sure your pads aren’t too used up, especially the finer grits
 - 4. Finish the ball to the desired texture.

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
