



How to clone the sheet

Then you can name the update the name of the sheet

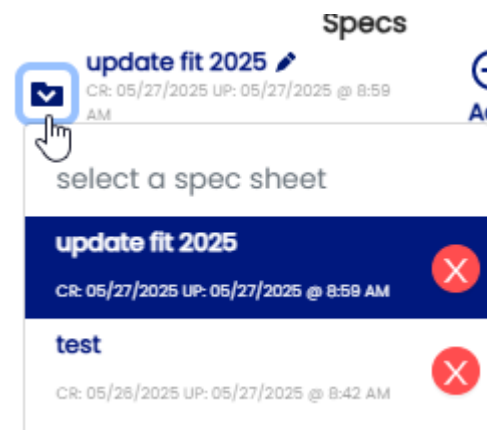
